Entry fee: \$125.00 per bird, 5 for \$500.00 (1 rotation bird), 12 for \$1,000 (2 rotation birds).
4 birds from any one breeder per handler, the 5th bird will be placed on rotation.

Birds will be received from March 1st to June 1st 2016. Replacements accepted up to June 15th.
Payment must accompany birds or birds will be returned to breeder.
Make checks out to CAP City 2016 I.F. Convention.
Birds to be shipped in approved postal boxes only, breeder pays for shipping.
All birds will be vaccinated against PMV and Salmonella upon arrival.

All non-specified handler birds will go on rotation.
No handler may handle their own birds, each handler required to enter a minimum of 2 birds.

Shipping location to be announced.
All birds in the I.F. Convention Race are subject to drug testing.
Convention Race will abide by I.F. race rules.
The first 25 birds clocked will be auctioned off after the race.
All other birds become the property of the handler.
